It is normal for the printer to show "Non Brother Toner" message when installing compatible toner cartridges. Please click "Yes" to complete the cartridge replacement.

If "445, 446" or "Cartridge error" warning message occurs on your printer, please restarting the printer to switch the serial number to resolve the issue.



## How to disable Auto Firmware update on your printer

Oftentimes, OEM will release new firmware to block out serial codes used by the aftermarket chip, resulting in detecting errors and preventing users from using non-OEM toner cartridges. It's recommended to turn off the Auto Firmware update feature on the printer to avoid possible serial codes block caused by the new firmware update.



- Step 1. Go to Home screen on your printer and select Settings
- Step 2. Under Settings and select All Settings
- Step 3. Under All Settings and select Machine Information
- Step 4. Under Machine Information and select Firmware Auto Check
- Step 5. Under Firmware Auto Check and select Off
